## This funding will be used to

- Redevelop an engaging school numeracy curriculum plan compliant with the Australian Curriculum, and incorporating inquiry teaching strategies.
- NAPLAN Numeracy upper 2 bands - Year 3 - 40%, Year 5 - 35%
- 100% of classroom teachers participate in Maths Coaching lead by PEAC and teacher aides participate in target numeracy upskilling session lead by Deputy Principal.

## Our initiatives include

- Employ a speech language pathologist 1 day a week to support and develop programs for students with complex speech language needs and provide staff upskilling in speech programs.
- Provide release time for teachers to work in teams on targeted programs including curriculum development, professional learning teams and devising support plans for individuals and small groups.
- Support Reading blocks with teacher aide allocation to support all learners, capture regular student data and track progress towards expected school targets.
- Professional development to establish professional learning teams and peer coaching
- Resources for numeracy and literacy units to support student engagement and school priorities
